# New Employee Scholarship Program Rules

## AM I ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for a Milacron scholarship, you must meet the following general eligibility requirements:

- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must be interning, co-op, part time, full time employed by Milacron LLC by the start of the fall semester
- Must be taking plastics or manufacturing related courses (engineering, tooling, machining)
- Programs can include the following at any accredited trade school/university with related programming
  - ✓ 2-year certificate
  - ✓ 2-year Associate's degree
  - ✓ 4-year Bachelor's degree

## HOW DO I APPLY?

In order to be considered, you must follow these steps and submit an application package.

**Step 1:** Complete and sign the application form.

**Step 2:** Complete the additional requirements as documented:

- Two letters of recommendation from teachers/school officials
- High school transcripts
- List of current and past school activities and achievements
- List of employment history, including involvement in manufacturing or the plastics industry
- Name what college you plan to attend and what major you will enroll in
- Summary of why applying for scholarship, qualifications and education/career goals in the industry
  - ✓ Includes details on course(s) to be funded by scholarship

## HOW ARE DECISIONS MADE?

Milacron scholarships are intended to encourage and support capable new employees with interest and potential in the fields of manufacturing and related careers. **Academic Achievement:** Grades, courses selected, interdisciplinary skills/interests.

**Interest in the Field:** Knowledge of manufacturing/plastics fields. Demonstrated interest through activities/jobs, potential for related career.

## WHO MAKES THE DECISIONS?

Milacron's scholarship program is administered by the Milacron Scholarship Selection Committee. The program's rules govern application for, and granting of, all scholarships.

Scholarship recipients will be notified beginning August 15.</p> |
